

# TEAM VBNTURE. AN INTRODUCTION ...


We are three soldiers, bonded by a desire to push ourselves to our limits and make a positive difference whilst doing so.

We met at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst in 2019 and soon became firm friends.





We are also very proud of the units in which we serve. 30% will be donated to our three regimental charities.








